The Association for the Preservation of Geneseo was founded by people who care enough about the future to preserve the best of the past. In 1973, the General Education Committee of the Geneseo Garden Club called a general meeting to discuss ways to help save the Big Tree Inn from imminent destruction. The meeting was attended by about 75 people. From this first meeting a smaller group organized and continued to meet and later formally organized as The Association for the Preservation of Geneseo.

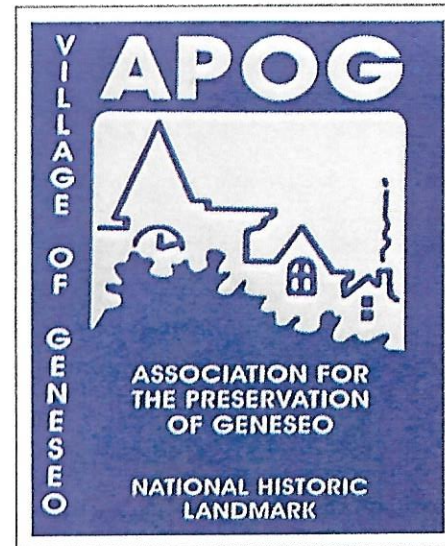

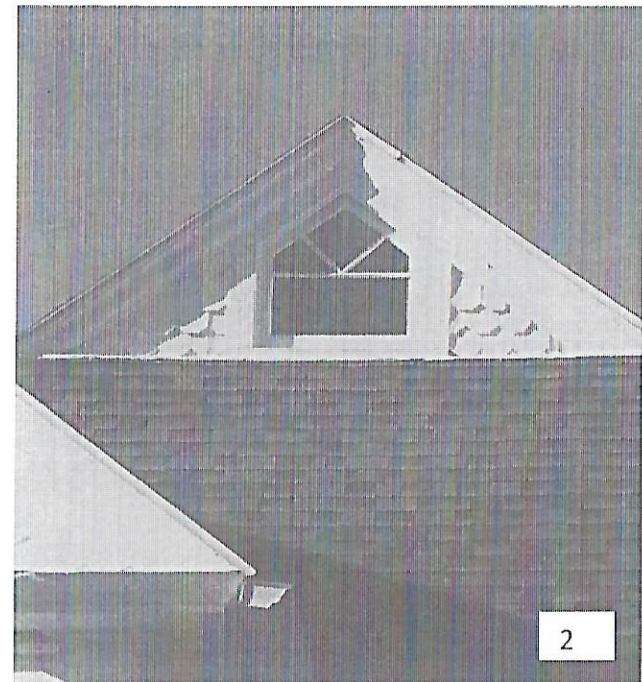
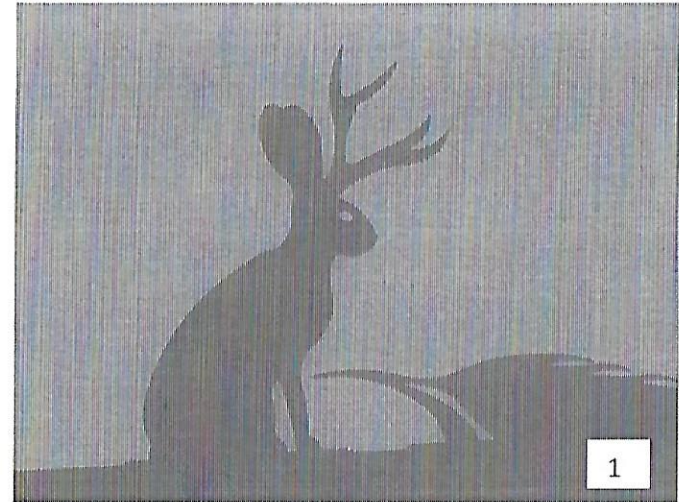
Contest winners will be announced at the fifth annual Genesee Valley Chicken Wing Festival on September 22, 2018. Winners will also be notified by mail.
